



## **HOW IT WORKS**

Welcome To Cornerstone Therapeutic Riding Center. We would like to introduce you to our lesson format and help you to become familiar with Cornerstone's lesson fees, policies, and procedures.

1. Each session is eight weeks with one lesson per week on the same day and time each week. There is a 2 week break in between each session.
2. The cost per lesson is \$50. (In the case of financial hardship, please speak to Cornerstone's Executive Director).
3. Private lessons are 30-40 minutes which includes mounting and dismounting
4. Semi-private and group lessons are 45 minutes – 60 minutes which includes mounting and dismounting.
5. Long pants (no shorts) and closed toed shoes with a heel must be worn
6. Cornerstone may cancel when weather is inclement; too hot/cold/raining, we may do ground work/non-mounted lessons when mounted lessons are not possible.
7. Cornerstone is a 501C3 non-profit organization and is 95% volunteer driven.
8. Cornerstone takes a summer break in August and a winter break in December.
9. If you are unable to attend a lesson, a 48 hour notice is to be given by phone or by email (no text). Failure to do so could result in forfeiture of your riding privileges. Students must arrive on time. Consistent tardiness may also result in forfeiture of riding privileges. If you are 15 minutes late (or more) we will be unable to provide a mounted lesson but will offer an alternative activity with the horses for the remaining lesson time.
